



What is involved in being a TASBO Board Member?

- Number of regular meetings each year
 - 2 at the Annual Conference - One on Tuesday and a short one on Friday after the new Board members are installed
 - 1 held in conjunction with the Leadership Academy in April
 - 1 held in conjunction with the Summer Conference in June
 - 1 held in August to evaluate the Executive Director and approve the budget for the subsequent year
 - 1 held in November (or) December
- Other responsibilities include:
 - Attend Committee meetings as Board Liaison (meet in the fall and at the Annual Conference)
 - Attend Affiliate meetings (at least once each year)
 - Stay in touch with assigned committees and affiliates during the year
- Expenses - TASBO reimburses for travel, lodging and meals for:
 - Attendance at Board meetings
 - Attendance at Committee meetings
 - Attendance at Affiliate meetings
 - Presentations at events such as Budget Academy if the member does not attend the Academy
 - Special activities if the Board member is asked to represent TASBO
 - Board members are expected to reimburse TASBO for guest's expenses

- TASBO waives registration fee for Board members to attend TASBO's Annual Conference
 - TASBO budgets \$1,000 per Board member to attend the ASBO Annual Meeting (reimbursement may be higher if all Board members do not attend)
 - Board members are responsible for their membership fee to TASBO and ASBO (ASBO dues for officers paid by TASBO)
- Mentors
 - Board President assigns an experienced Board member as a mentor for new Board members
