Membership Levels

TASBO's membership dues are for a 12-month period; benefits begin on the first day of the month following receipt of full payment.

- **Institutional Member** employer designates the individual and retains the right to transfer the membership.
- **Individual Member** membership held solely by the individual and is nontransferable.

Associate Member Individuals employed by a management services company or any for-profit entity. These members may participate in TASBO activities and have a voice in discussions, but they have no voting privileges and are not eligible to hold office in TASBO.

Retired Member available to TASBO members who have retired from school business management, but do not have the required years of service and/or membership to be considered for Life Memberships. Retired members may vote.

Student Member non-voting members currently enrolled in a college or university and currently pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in the field of business and/or education.

Life Members awarded by the Board of Directors to qualified individuals. Life members have the same privileges as active members.

Certification

Certification offers TASBO members and non-members an opportunity to expand their professional credibility and knowledge base. It also provides school business officials with a level of respect and recognition among their peers along with a more competitive edge in the job market. Through year-round certification courses across Texas, TASBO offers three categories of certification:

- Registered Texas School Business Administrator (RTSBA),
- Certified Texas School Business Official (CTSBO), and
- Certified Texas School Business Specialist (CTSBS).
